



Scotia Scholars^{OM} Awards (Master's Level) 2015 - 2016 Funded Recipients

The Scotia Scholars^{OM} Award is a funding opportunity available under NSHRF's Research Trainee Funding Program. The Scotia Scholar Award is intended to provide financial support to high caliber trainees engaged in health research related academic study at Nova Scotia universities. The goal of the Scotia Scholar Award is to support the development of the next generation of highly qualified health researchers and leaders in the Nova Scotia health research enterprise.

The award is tenable only at eligible Nova Scotia universities. Each eligible university allocates a pre-determined amount of funding. Applicants are evaluated by their institution based on their past academic, leadership, and research achievements

Funding

The value and duration of the 2015-16 Scotia Scholars^{OM} Award (Master's Level) is \$10,000 over a 12-month (non-renewable) term.
