



Scotia Scholars^{OM} Awards (Undergraduate Level) 2015 - 2016 Funded Recipients

The Scotia Scholars^{OM} Award is intended to provide financial support to high caliber trainees engaged in health research related academic study at Nova Scotia universities. The goal of the Scotia Scholars^{OM} Award is to support the development of the next generation of highly qualified health researchers and leaders in the Nova Scotia health research enterprise, as well as encourage continued interest in health research careers.

Each eligible Nova Scotia university allocates a pre-determined amount of funding to awards at the undergraduate, Master's and/or PhD level. Applicants are evaluated by their institution based on their past academic, leadership, and research achievements.

Funding

The value and duration of the 2015-16 Scotia Scholars^{OM} Award (Undergraduate Level) is \$5,000 over an 8-month (non-renewable) term.
