



## Colleen Elliott Award (Excellence in Cancer Research) Recipients

Established in 2011, the Colleen Elliott Award was established by the NSHRF to honour excellence in cancer research training and is awarded to a research trainee who demonstrates the greatest promise and potential for excellence in cancer research. The Colleen Elliott Award was created to recognize and honour Colleen Elliott's contribution to volunteerism and supporting the advancement of the health research enterprise in Nova Scotia. Applicants of the Scotia Scholars Award (Master's or Doctoral level) whose research focus relates to cancer may apply for this additional financial support.

The Colleen Elliott Award is awarded annually. In addition to the prestigious recognition of this award, a one-time contribution of \$5,000 is made by the NSHRF to assist the recipient with his/her research training.
